Minutes:-

The Minutes of the Committee Meeting held on Monday 12th November 2018 were proposed, seconded and unanimously accepted as a true record.

Matters Arising:-

There were none.

Chairman's Report:-

Roy thanked everyone for attending and wished them a Happy and Prosperous New Year. He also welcomed Cllr Michael Mathias to his first meeting. He went on to report that he had been invited to take part in the Civic Carol Service as Chair of Twinning. He also reported that he had received a letter from the Oberburgermeister of Oberkirch apologizing for the fact that they could not visit Haverfordwest this year but that they would be visiting with a large party in July 2020. The party would include Herr Willie Stachele who was the Oberburgermeister who made the first approaches regarding a Twinning Agreement over thirty years ago.

Roy then reported on the meeting he and Derek had with the Head teacher of Haverfordwest High VC School. It had been a pleasant meeting in which Mrs Harries had accepted the suggestion that the school should send a group of young musicians to perform in Oberkirch. Two teachers and twelve students had been the suggested number and there was the possibility that she would attend herself. 12th July 2019 had become the preferred date because of the availability of both teachers and pupils.

It was hoped that Roy and Derek would soon have another meeting with the Head to firm up arrangements and ascertain the availability of the Tasker Milward Hall for a concert to raise money for the students travel expenses. Roy said that the Chairman's Chain had been brought up to date and thanks were afforded Shirley for repairs at no cost to the Association.

Financial Update:-

Derek reported that there was little change from his last report. He had not received a bill for the final night at Broad Haven and was hopeful that he would not receive one in the future. The Bank Balance stood at £5,267.68p.

Future Programme:-

Charles reported that he had approached coach companies for prices. As this was reckoned to be the busiest time of the year, only three had quoted.
